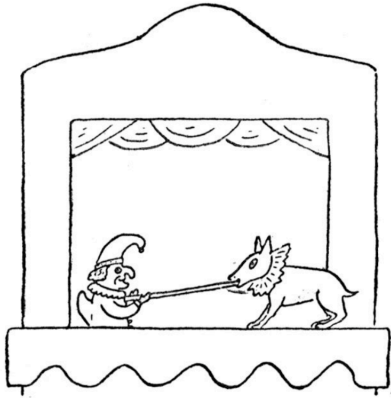


Getting Punchy
